

European Studies Minor Planning Guide

Students plan their minor in consultation with a European Studies faculty adviser. All courses taken for the minor must be taken for a letter grade, and must be passed with a C- or better. The minor in European Studies requires seven courses, at least five of which must be upper-division courses. A maximum of two 199 or 198 courses, and a maximum of three Study Abroad Courses may be petitioned to fulfill minor requirements.

Language Proficiency Requirement: ALL minors must demonstrate basic proficiency in a single European language other than English by completing four quarters of language instruction (or equivalent).
